

## Aid to Myanmar (Burma) Cyclone Victims

You can help - Gifts both large and small can make a difference - each individual life touched brings hope, and hope is desperately needed.

£102	Provides the basic needs for a family of 5 who've been made destitute, lost everything, ie food staples, 2 blankets, 2 sleeping mats, 2 mosquito nets, one set of clothes for each family member, basic medicines
£153	Provides for the repair of house/provide roofing or building simple bamboo & thatch hut (most village houses were either blown down or at least lost their roofs in the path of the cyclone)
£1,020	Medical clinic with medicines to serve a cyclone hit village
£1,020	Artesian well to provide clean water for a cyclone hit village
£13	Emergency Food kits (£1.30 each) for 10 children including: sardine, high energy biscuits, dry rice, tea, roasted soybean, milk powder, oral rehydration salt and bottled water
£13	Women's kits (£1.30 each) - for 10 women including comb, nail clipper, hand towel, soap, 2 panty, sanitary pads, sandalwood sun protection, and prenatal vitamins
£26	For a bag of rice. Rice is the staple food for Burmese people - 1 bag feeds a family for nearly a month
£6	For a case of drinking water bottles - much disease is spread through dirty water
£5	Plastic sheet for temporary shelter
£6	Mosquito net (large) for 2 adults and 2 children this is essential for prevention of malaria
£357	Will repair the roof of a children's home and residence in Yangon (zinc, tins, nails wood)
£510	Will provide one month basic food and water supplies for a children's home in Yangon: Rice, oil for cooking, drinking and bathing water, vegetables, candles
£255	Will provide Medical care and clothing, sleeping mats and mosquito nets for a children's home in Yangon



**The overall budget for this relief work being sought by our partner is £1.5 million.**
